John 8:1-11

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Remember the Gospel of John was written around 85-90 AD much later than the other Gospel which were written somewhere between 50-60 AD.
 - a) Matthew and Luke begin with the genealogy of Jesus.
 - b) Mark begins with the life of Jesus.
 - c) And John goes back much further John 1:1
- 2. John 20:30-31
- 3. **REMEMBER**: "Whenever there is an attempt to diminish the Deity of Christ you will find a Greater Glorification.

THREE WAYS JESUS REVEALS HIS GLORY WHENEVER THERE'S AN ATTEMPT TO DIMINISH HIS DEITY

- I. JESUS GLORY CAN BE SEEN IN HIS IDENTIFICATION WITH THE LAW
 - 1. Vs 2
 - 2. Vs 3-5
 - 3. Vs 6
 - a) Jesus makes His identification with the Law Exodus 31:8

II. JESUS GLORY CAN BE SEEN IN HIS CLARIFICATION OF THE LAW

- 1. Remember Jesus did not come to abolish the Law but to fulfill the Law.
- 2. Vs 6a
- 3. Deuteronomy 22:22
- 4. Vs 7a
 - a) "And they continued to ask Him"
 - 1) "continued" means to be persistent
 - b) "he stood up and said to them"

- 5. **Vs 7b**
 - a) "Let him who is without sin among you"
 - b) "be the first to throw the first stone"
- 6. **VERY IMPORTANT**: The first stone or stones were to be thrown at the accused were reserved for those who witnesses the adultery.
 - a) Deuteronomy 17:6; 19:15
- 7. Romans 3:23
- 8. LISTEN UP: The favorite Bible verses of our wicked culture are
 - a) Matthew 7:1

"Judge not, that you be not judged"

b) John 8:7

"Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw the first stone"
