#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. History is simply mankind's response to God's Word.
  - a) Proverbs 14:34
    - 1) FACT #1: Nations that fear God enjoy His favor.
    - 2) FACT #2: Nations that don't fear God experience His severity.
  - b) Bringing it home:
    - 1) People (individuals) that fear God enjoy His favor.
    - 2) Individuals who do not fear God experience His severity.
- 2. For the most part people today do not embrace absolute beliefs.
  - a) They take a little bit of everything:
  - b) That's called "Pluralism"
    - 1) Pluralism in religion holds the idea that many roads lead to heaven.
- 3. The Judges here were not black robed jurists arbitrating law.
  - a) The Hebrew word "Judge" means to deliver or to rule.

    - 1) Physically and spiritually

  - a) When it comes, they cry out to God for deliverance.
  - b) And God sends a Judge (deliverer) one who judges.
