# "The Corruption of Wealth" James 5:1-6

## INTRODUCTION:

- 1. DEFINITION of WORLDLINESS!!
  - a) "Is to exclude God from our thoughts and attitudes in every area of life."
- 2..BIG QUESTION: What would cause us who claim to know Christ, to plan our lives as if God doesn't exist?
- 3. ANSWER: Materialism
  - a) Materialism is the WORSHIP of material things.
- 4. The Believer who is **GROWING UP IN CHRIST** is the believer who has learned to defeat the problem of materialism.
- 5. God has a lot to say about MONEY.
  - a) Jesus told 38 parables in the N.T.
    - 1) 16 of them deal with MONEY.
  - b) One out of every 10 N.T. verses mentions possessions.
  - c) The Bible contains over 500 verses on **PRAYER** and another 500 verses on **FAITH**.
  - d) BUT there are over 2000 verses in the BIBLE on MONEY.

#### HOW TO GET A HANDLE ON MATERIALISM

#### I. A WRONG ATTITUDE TOWARD MONEY

#### A. IT'S A SINFUL ATTITUDE

- 1. Very Important When the Bible speaks against the SIN of MATERIALISM.
  - a) It's not talking about how much you have!!
  - b) BUT your ATTITUDE toward what you have.
- 2. GOD'S CONCERN is your ATTITUDE toward what you HAVE.
- 3. Proverbs 10:22
- 4. Deuteronomy 8:18
- 5. A MATERIALIST is someone who makes GOLD into a GOD.

- 6. The Bible refers to MATERIALISM as COVETOUSNESS.
  - a) 1 Corinthians 5:11; 6:9-10
    - 1) "greed" qk covetousness
- 7. "How do you know if you are a MATERIALIST?"
  - a) **TEST #1** Are you content with what you have? Or do you always desire something more?
  - b) TEST #2 When GOD and GOLD come into CONFLICT... Who WINS?

## B. A LOSS OF PERSPECTIVE

- 1. Proverbs 11:28
- 2. Mark 10:25
- 3. Anyone who has money and is miserable has a spiritual PROBLEM.

## II. THE PRICE OF MATERIALISM

## A. MISERY IS COMING

- 1. Vs 1
- 2. Notice the language of the FOOLISHNESS of HOARDING.
  - a) Vs 2
    - 1) "Your riches have rotted"
    - 2) "and your garments are moth-eaten"
      - a. Clothes could have been given to the less fortunate.
  - b) Vs 3
    - 1) "Your gold and silver have corroded"
      - a. Money could have purchased help and healing for those in need.
- 3.1 Corinthians 3:10-15
- 4. Romans 14:10-12
- 5. 2 Corinthians 5:6-10
- 6. 2 Corinthians 13:5
- 7. Vs 3

- a) "and their corrosion"
  - 1) "corrosion" poison of their greed
- b) "will be evidence against you"
  - 1) No doubt James has a future Judgment in mind.
- c) "and will eat your flesh like fire"
  - 1) Just like corrosion eats up metal, it will eat at those who hoard their abundance.
- d) "You have laid up treasures in the last days"

## B. THE <u>FUTILITY</u> OF MATERIALISM

- 1. **WOW!!!** When you substitute GOLD for GOD, you will NEVER get the BENEFIT you were EXPECTING.
- 2. Vs 3
  - a) MONEY can buy you BED, but it can't BUY YOU SLEEP.
  - b) MONEY can buy you BOOKS, but it can't BUY YOU BRAINS.
  - c) MONEY can buy you a HOUSE, but it can't BUY YOU A HOME.
  - d) MONEY can buy you MEDICINE, but it can't BUY YOU HEALTH.
- 3. When you love your **STUFF** so much that you **ONLY** tip God a few BUCKS and NEGLECT the WORK of GOD...You are a MATERIALIST.
- 4. Vs 3
  - a) "will be evidence against you"
- C. THE <u>DEVASTATING</u> COST OF MATERIALISM
  - 1. FOR THE UNBELIEVER
    - a) Luke 18:18-27
    - b) Luke 16:19-31 (Vs 19)(Vs 25)
  - 2. Negligence cost the **RICH MAN ETERNITY** with God.
  - 3. LISTEN UP: As with any sin, a TRUE BELIEVER will experience CONVICTION.
  - 4.1 Corinthians 6:9-11

#### III. WHAT MATERIALISM LOOKS LIKE

## A. HOARDING STUFF

- a) "you have laid up treasure"
- 2. 2 Corinthians 12:14

## 3. BIBLICAL REASONS FOR SAVING

- a) To invest in God's WORK.
- b) To provide for your **NEEDS**.
- c) To provide for your families FUTURE.
- d) For an EMERGENCY.
- e) TO MEET THE NEEDS OF OTHERS

## 4. WHAT HOARDING LOOKS LIKE:

- a) Collects and stores out of GREED.
- b) Accumulates more for SELF with NO REGARD for OTHERS.

## B. <u>USING</u> OTHERS

- 1. Vs 4a
- 2. Cheating people what is due them.
- 3. **Vs 4b** 
  - a) "the Lord of Hosts"

# C. TWISTING JUSTICE

1. Vs 6

## D. SELF-INDULGENCE

- 1. Vs 5
- 2. Luxury is not a sin!!!
  - a) Stealing from God to get it is!!
- 3. "Self indulgence" excess, more than enough but can't get enough.
