THE PSALM 23 JOURNEY

PSALM 23

Intro:

Psalm 23 reminds us to live our lives confidently trusting in the Lord no matter what we're going through because He will care for us.

I. THE COMFORTABLE PART (v. 1-3)

- a. "The Lord is **MY** Shepherd."
 - 1. His personal relationship with God was the foundation of David's comfort.
 - 2. Psalm 23 is written to those who know Jesus **PERSONALLY** as their good Shepherd.

I. THE COMFORTABLE PART (v. 1-3)

- b. A Good Shepherd Makes <u>**REST**</u> Possible for His Sheep by Making Sure Their Needs are Met.
 - God's care for you is demonstrated through His <u>PROVISION</u> (v. 2).
 Mat. 6:31-33
 - God's care for you is demonstrated through His GUIDANCE (v. 3). 2
 Tim. 3:16, 17; Ps. 119:105

"his name's sake" - God's provision and guidance has nothing to do with who $\underline{\text{WE}}$ are and everything to do with who $\underline{\text{HE}}$ is.

I. THE COMFORTABLE PART (v. 1-3)

c. When Comfortable, Beware of COMPLACENCY.

II. THE <u>DISORIENTING</u> PART (v. 4)

- a. Even in the valley of the shadow of death, God cared for David as a shepherd.
 - God's care for you is demonstrated through His PRESENCE (v. 4).

Our security is NOT found in our environment but in the PRESENCE of our **SHEPHERD**.

II. THE <u>DISORIENTING</u> PART (v. 4)

b. "...Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me."

God's protection comes in the forms of:

1. DEFENSE (rod)

For believers today, the rod symbolizes God's Word. (2 Cor. 10:4-5; John 17:17)

2. DISCIPLINE (staff)

The staff represents the Holy Spirit's presence in our lives. (Gal. 5:16)

III. THE <u>REWARDING</u> PART (v. 5-6)

a. Dark valleys often produce deeper **INTIMACY** with God.

The problems don't always go away- but we have learned to trust God even in their presence. The situation hasn't changed- **YOU** have changed.

b. The Lord is my **HOST**.

David now sees his relationship with God in a new dimension- God is welcoming Him as a **FRIEND**.

III. THE <u>REWARDING</u> PART (v. 5-6)

GOODNESS and MERCY pursue you all the way to heaven.

"You can trust the Lord with more than just your eternity- you can trust Him with your here and now, too."
