THE POWER OF THE TONGUE

JAMES 3:1-12

Introduction

The tongue is **DYNAMITE** in the mouth. It has incredible power to bring people together or to blow them apart.

YOUR SPEECH MEASURES YOUR MATURITY. (v.1-2)

- 1. "...we all stumble..."
 - Proverbs 10:19
 - a. "if anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man..."
 - b. If you control your tongue, you can control the rest of your body
- 2. We tend to measure our spiritual maturity by our "religious acts."
 - James 1:26

YOUR WORDS HAVE THE POWER TO DIRECT (v.3-4)

- 1. A bit guides the entire body of the horse
 - a. Your tongue can steer the course of your life. It can get you into trouble. Learning to control it can keep you out of trouble.
 - **b.** Proverbs 18:21
- 2. A rudder directs the ship.
 - a. James 1:19,20; Proverbs 13:3
 - b. "driven by strong winds" you can't control outward circumstances but you need to control your tongue.

YOUR WORDS HAVE THE POWER TO DESTROY (v.5-8)

1. The tongue is a **FIRE**.

- a. Words may seem small, but they spread <u>FAST</u> and their destruction is <u>FAR-</u><u>REACHING</u>.
- b. Like a forest recovering from a fire, it can take years for **TRUST** to be rebuilt in a relationship.
- c. "staining the body" Our words pollute our good works.
- d. "entire course of life" words have a way of coming back to bite us throughout our life. The follow us like a criminal record.
- e. "set on fire by hell" Our words can be empowered by hell itself.

YOUR WORDS HAVE THE POWER TO DESTROY (v.5-8)

- 2. The tongue is an **UNTAMABLE BEAST**.
- 3. The tongue is a **POISON**.
 - a. The tongue is completely unpredictable, unstable, and deadly.
 - b. Ps. 140:3

YOUR WORDS HAVE THE POWER TO REVEAL YOUR HEART (v.9-12)

- 1. In the natural world, things produce what they were designed to produce.
 - a. A spring produces either fresh water or salt water.
 - b. Fig trees produce figs. Grapevines produce grapes.

YOUR WORDS HAVE THE POWER TO REVEAL YOUR HEART (v.9-12)

- 2. Your tongue **CONTRADICTS** itself when it blesses God and curses people.
 - a. Speaking ill of someone made in God's image is the same thing as **CURSING** God himself.
 - b. Which of our words does God believe? The ones that bless him or curse the people made in His image?

YOUR WORDS HAVE THE POWER TO REVEAL YOUR HEART (v.9-12)

- 3. Your words are tied to your **WILL**.
 - a. v.4 "ship is steered by the rudder wherever the WILL of the pilot directs."
 - **b.** Matthew 12:34
