Revelation 11:15-19

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. In Chapters 4 & 5 the "church" is in Heaven.
- 2. In Chapter 5:1-5
 - a) Here we see the Scroll (Title Deed) with the 7 Seals and the Lamb who is worthy.
- 3. In Chapter 6 we see the FIRST SIX SEAL JUDGMENTS
 - a) **SEAL #1** White Horse False Peace
 - 1) The Antichrist steps onto the scene.
 - b) SEAL #2 Red Horse War and Bloodshed
 - c) SEAL #3 Black Horse Starvation, disease and famine
 - 1) Food shortage
 - d) SEAL #4 Death and Hades
 - e) SEAL #5 Martyrs under the Altar
 - 1) Those who were slain for the Word of God and their testimony!
 - 2) Revelation 6:9-10
 - f) **SEAL #6** Natural Disasters
 - 1) Earthquakes and Meteors hitting the earth.
 - 2) Revelation 6:15-17
- 4. Chapter 7 is a Parenthesis (Interlude)
 - a) 144,000 Jewish evangelists sealed by God.
 - b) Revelation 7:9-11
 - c) WE SEE THE GRACE OF GOD
- 5. Chapter 8 SEAL #7
 - a) **Vs 1-2**
 - b) Which opens up the 7 Trumpet Judgments
- 6. THE SEVEN TRUMPET JUDGMENTS
 - a) TRUMPET #1 Revelation 8:7
 - 1) 1/3 of the earth is burned up. $1/3^{rd}$ of the Trees and all green grass.
 - b) TRUMPET #2 Revelation 8:8-9
 - 1) 1/3rd of all Sea Creatures die
 - c) TRUMPET #3 Revelation 8:10-11
 - 1) 1/3rd of Fresh Water poisoned by Wormwood
 - d) TRUMPET #4 Revelation 8:12
 - 1) 1/3rd of the Sun, Moon, and Stars darkened. From 24 to 16 hour days.

- e) TRUMPET #5 Revelation 9:1-12
 - 1) Demonic creatures from the Abyss torment the lost for 5 months.
- f) TRUMPET #6 Revelation 9:13-21
 - 1) 200 million man army from the east
 - 2) 1/3rd of mankind is killed
- 7. Revelation 10 is another Parenthesis between the 6th and 7th TRUMPET.
 - a) Revelation 10:1-7
 - b) A vision of the Old Testament Angel of Jehovah Jesus Christ
- 8. The Interlude between the 6^{th} and 7^{th} TRUMPET has concluded and loud voices are heard in heaven Revelation 11:14.
 - a) Vs 15
 - 1) When the SEVENTH TRUMPET is sounded, the final 7 BOWL JUDGMENTS of God upon the earth will begin.
- 9. In Revelation 11:15-19 we get a glimpse into the Throne Room of Heaven.
 - a) And we get a preview of things to come.

I. THE ANTICIPATION OF THE KINGDOM

- 1. Vs 15
 - a) "The Kingdom of the World has become the Kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ."
 - b) "and He shall reign forever and ever"
- 2. The events of Chapters 12-18 describe that transition of power to Jesus as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.
- 3. LISTEN UP: Many believers are shocked when they discover that the kingdom of this world @ present does not belong to Christ.
 - a) The Kingdom of this world is under the authority of Satan.
 - 1) John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11
 - b) Jesus refers to Satan's Kingdom
 - 1) Matthew 12:26
- 4. **SO HERE IT IS**: It's the removal of Satan's kingdom and the establishment of Christ's Kingdom which is the end result of the book of Revelation.
- 5. Daniel 2:44; 7:13-14

II. OUR WORSHIP OF THE KING

- 1. Vs 16a
 - a) 24 is the number of all "inclusiveness". That's us!! We are there.
- 2. Revelation 6:10
 - a) "How long O Lord...?
- 3. Vs 17

III. EXPECTING THE CONSUMMATION OF THE END

- 1. Notice Vs 18
- 2. Prophetic language is written in a way that appears to be narrow.
- 3. Notice **Isaiah 61:1-2**
 - a) Between Vs 1-2a and the rest of verse 2 is the distance between the 1^{st} and second coming.
- 4. Between these 2 phrases is 2000 years.
- 5. Now look @ Luke 4:18-21
- 6.1 Corinthians 15:23-24
 - a) "But each in his own order"
 - 1) "Christ the first fruits" Past tense
 - 2) "then @ His coming, those who belong to Christ" @ the Rapture
 - b) Vs 24
 - 1) That's after the Millenium!!! 1000 years
- 7. Revelation 11:18
 - a) Contains an outline of what is going to happen in the rest of the book.

A. GOD'S JUDGMENT OF THE NATIONS

- 1. Vs 18
 - a) "The nations raged, but your wrath came"
- 2. Psalm 2:1-5

B. GOD'S JUDGMENT AGAINST THE DEAD

- 1. Vs 18
 - a) "and time for the dead to be judged"
- 2. Cf. Chapter 20:4-5, 11-15
 - a) This is where the unsaved dead are judged.
- 3. We must be careful not to get the judgments mixed up.
 - a) The Great White Throne is not for believers.
 - 1) You don't want to be here.
 - b) The Judgment Seat of Christ is where believers will be judged.
 - 1) This takes place @ the Rapture
 - 2) Not for Salvation but for works.
 - 3) 1 Corinthians 3:11-15
 - 4) 2 Corinthians 5:10

C. GOD REWARDS BELIEVERS

- 1. Vs 18
 - a) "and for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints, and those who fear your name, both small and great"
 - 1) "prophets" O.T. believers
 - 2) "saints" N.T. believers
 - 3) "those who fear your name" Tribulation believers

D. THE <u>DESTRUCTION</u> OF DEMONS

- 1. Vs 18
 - a) "and for destroying the destroyers of the earth"
- 2. These are the demons who have been turned loose as emissaries of Satan to wreak havoc on God's creation during the Tribulation.
 - a) Satan is the great destroyer and anyone who follows him is a "destroyer of the earth."
- 3. Vs 16-17
 - a) Once again we find the Church worshiping together in Heaven.
- 4. **Very Important**: Everything that needs to take place to bring about the establishment of God's Kingdom will in fact take place.
- 5. WOW!!! We will worship from the absolute certainty of the prophetic PICTURE.

6. JUST REMEMBER: Those who should be judged will be judged.

 - a) "the ark of the covenant" Every Jew understood the Ark represented God's presence.
 - 1) The Two Tablets The 10 Commandments
 - a) God's Law
 - b) The certainty of God's Word
 - 2) Bowl of Manna God's sufficiency and provision
 - 3) Aaron's rod that budded God's life Hebrews 9:4

2. Vs 19

a) We are reminded that God is in the midst of our most difficult times in our lives.
