INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Judgments that have pounded this earth.
 - a) The SEVEN Seal Judgments; SEVEN Trumpet Judgments; and the SEVEN Bowl Judgments
 - 1) SEVEN Seal Judgments Revelation 6 & 8:1-6
 - a. Parenthesis Chapter 7
 - 2) SEVEN Trumpet Judgments Revelation 8-9 & 11:14-19
 - a. Parenthesis Chapter 10
 - 3) SEVEN Bowl/Vial Judgments Revelation 16
- 2. It is helpful to remember that Chapter 17 and 18 would be considered parenthetical.
 - a) Chronologically Chapter 19 (The 2nd coming) follows Chapter 16:17-21, the final Bowl Judgment.
 - b) Chapters 17 & 18 give information concerning the destruction of Babylon.
- 3. Chapter 17 paints a sobering picture of a worldwide religious system which began all the way back in Genesis 10-11 and is sanctioned by the Antichrist before he turns and destroys it toward the end of the Great Tribulation,
- 4. During the Gulf War, it was reported that Saddam Hussein wanted to rebuild the great city of Babylon and a replica of the Tower of Babel.
- 5. Babylon will become, prior to its destruction, the third city out of which the Antichrist will operate during the Tribulation:
- 6. Daniel 4:30
 - a) Today we call that "humanism" or Self-Worship. "I"

I. THE <u>REASON'S</u> FOR BABYLON'S JUDGMENT

- Notice 18:1
 - Here we see an angel pronouncing judgment upon the city of Babylon.
 - In Chapter 17 we saw judgment pronounced on Babylon ecclesiastically.
 - In Chapter 18 we will see Babylon commercially.
- Revelation 18:2
 - "Fallen, fallen is Babylon the Great!"
 - It means to fall in a moment!!
 - 18:19

THERE ARE FOUR REASONS GIVEN FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF BABYLON

A. BECAUSE OF HER SINS

- 1. Vs 4
- 2. Vs 5
 - a) We are told that Babylon's sins "for her sins are heaped high as heaven"
 - 1) The term "heaped" means "to glue or weld together"
 - b) The city has become the habitation of every sort of unclean spirit and demonic power.

B. BECAUSE OF HER INFLUENCE

- 1. Vs 3
 - a) Not only is the city wicked and evil but she has influenced others to follow her wickedness.
 - b) Vs 3
 - 1) "and the kings of the earth have committed immorality with her"
- 2. The nations of the earth will come under the allure of Babylon's social, political, cultural, and commercial life.
 - a) All because they wanted those same "riches" for themselves, they will drink of the "wine" and fall into the trap of her influence.
- 3. Materialism and humanism will be the hall marks of this system.

C. BECAUSE OF HER UNFAITHFULNESS

- 1. Vs 7
 - a) "and she glorified herself"
- 2. Her words remind us of Satan's when he boasted that he would become like the most high.
- 3. Isaiah 14:14
- 4. Vs 7

D. BECAUSE OF HER PURSUIT OF LUXURY

- 1. Vs 12-13
 - a) 28 articles of merchandise!!
- 2. Articles of merchandise which have first place in men's hearts.
 - a) Gold, Silver, Jewels, and Pearls.
- 3. Articles of adornment.
 - a) Fine linen, purple cloth, silk, scarlet cloth.
- 4. Precious woods, metals, and stones:
 - a) Wood, metal and ivory.
- 5. Perfumes:
 - a) Vs 13
- 6. Livestock & other luxury items
 - a) Vs 13
- 7. Vs 13
 - a) "and slaves, that is, human souls." on.

II. THE TOTAL JUDGMENT ON BABYLON

- 1 Vs 21-23
 - a) "no more"
 - 1) Is found 6 times.
- 2. It is the strongest way the Greek language could say "not at all"

III. THE <u>RESPONSE</u> TO THE JUDGMENTS

A. KINGS WILL MOURN

- 1. Vs 9-10
 - a) The powerful will wail, and lament, the destruction of the one in whom the had put their hope.
- 2. The city and worldview they thought was their salvation, will be destroyed and with it their hopes of continued indulgence and prosperity.

B. MERCHANTS WILL MOURN

- 1. Vs 11-17a
- 2. WORLD financial crash is coming to a bank near you.
 - 1) Bank failure
 - 2) Stock Market crash

C. THE SHIPPING INDUSTRY WILL MOURN

1. Vs 17-19

IV. REJOICING OF THE SAINTS OVER BABYLON

- 1. The Kings, Merchants and Mariners all mourn over the destruction of Babylon.
- 2. But in Heaven, three other classes of people rejoice over the destruction of Babylon: Saints, Apostles, and Prophets.
- 3. WOW!!!! There will be unrestrained jubilation in Heaven as the people of God are at last vindicated and retribution is allotted upon the city which martyred them.
 - a) Vs 20, 24
- 4. Vs 21
- 5. Matthew 18:6

CONCLUSION:

- 1. What do we do with this?
- 2 Revelation 18:4-7
- 3. 2 Corinthians 16:14-18
 - a) This is a command. Not a suggestion.
- 4. There are two reasons to flee BABYLON:
 - a) To separate from the SINS OF BABYLON
 - b) To separate from the plagues and judgments coming upon the Antichrist and those who follow him.
- 5. Just remember that the Spirit of Babylon is alive and well.
