"The Second Coming of Jesus Christ"

Revelation 19:11-21

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Bible is filled with references to the Second Coming of Christ.
 - a) There are 1845 references to the Second Coming.
 - b) The Second Coming is emphasized in 17 Old Testament books.
 - c) And 70% of the chapters in the New Testament make reference to it.
 - 1) John 14:3
 - 2) Acts 1:11
- 2. The plethora of evidence does not keep scoffers from asking "Where is the promise of His coming?"
 - a) 2 Peter 3:4
 - b) Answer: Revelation 19:11-16
- 3. If the Bible makes anything clear, it is that the Second Coming of Christ will be a glorious event which all the world will witness.
- 4. Matthew 24:27 WOW!!!

I. THE SECOND ADVENT

- 1. ADVENT means the arrival
 - a) Matthew 1:21-25
 - 1) This is the first Advent
- 2. Revelation 19:11-13
 - a) The fact that John sees the door of heaven open, is significant.
 - 1) The first time it was open in **Revelation 4:1**, was at the Rapture of the Church.
 - b) Now the door in heaven is opened the 2^{nd} time, so the saints can return to earth with King Jesus.
- 3. Very Important: We are waiting for the Rapture @ any moment.
 - a) Followed by the 7-year Tribulation
 - b) @ the end of which time Jesus will return to earth in His Second Coming.

4. THE DIFFERENCE IN THE RAPTURE AND THE SECOND COMING

- a) In the Rapture: Christ comes for His Saints/Bride
 - 1) In the Second Coming: Christ comes with His Saints/Bride
- b) In the Rapture: The Church meets Jesus in the air.

- 1) In the Second Coming: Jesus descends to earth, to the Mount of Olivers.
- c) In the Rapture: The Coming of the Lord is with Blessing in mind.
 - 1) In the Second Coming: The coming of the Lord is with Judgment in mind.
- d) The Rapture: Is immanent
 - 1) The Second Coming: Seven years after the Rapture.
- 5. The One sitting on the White Horse is called by 3 names.
 - a) **Vs 11**
 - 1) Notice He is called "Faithful and True"
 - b) **Vs 13**
 - 1) "The Word of God"
 - c) Vs 16
 - 1) "King of Kings and Lord of Lords"
- 6. Vs 12
 - a) "His eyes are like a flame of fire"
 - 1) Cf. 1:14; 2:18
- 7. Vs 12
 - a) "and on His head are many diadems"
 - 1) This is a kingly ornament for the head representing dignity and authority.
- 8. Vs 13
 - a) "He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood"
 - 1) Zechariah 14:3-4
- 9. The Mount of Olives today has 2 high points. (Show Image)
 - a) And there is a natural division between them will be transformed into a great valley, stretching toward the east, from Jerusalem and extending down to Jericho
 - @ the Jordan river.
 - b) Matthew 24:27-31
- 10. For all eternity we will celebrate the shed blood which brought about our redemption from the penalty of sin.
- 11. Revelation 1:7
 - a) "and every eye shall see Him"
 - 1) TV, Social Media

II. THE ARMIES OF HEAVEN

- 1. Vs 14a
 - a) "And the armies of heaven"

- 2. Who is in this Army?
 - a) Every believer who died during church this Church Age or went home to be with the Lord @ the Rapture, will return with Christ @ His Second Coming.
- 3. Notice **Vs 14** again.
 - a) It says Armies (plural). More than one.
- 4. Here is one of my Holy Hunches!!!
 - a) Over the past 53 years Abortion has taken the lives of 70 million babies in America. Sacrificed right out of the womb!!
- 5. The purpose of our coming with Him is to help execute judgment upon those who have denied Christ during the Tribulation.
 - a) Jude 14-15
- 6. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10
- 7. How are they dressed
 - a) Vs 14
 - 1) They were "arrayed in fine linen, white and pure"
 - b) **Vs 7-8**

III. CHRIST'S INSTRUMENT OF WAR

- 1. Vs 15
 - a) "From his mouth comes a sharp sword"
- 2. This sword here is not the Word of God, but rather it is used symbolically to represent a sharp instrument of war with which Christ will smite the nations and establish His absolute rule.
 - a) This sword represents the deadly power of His words.
 - b) Christ will wield that sword with deadly effect as He strikes down the nations.
- 3. The dead will include all those gathered for battle @ Armageddon.
 - a) The rest of the world's unredeemed people will be judged and executed @ the judgment of the sheep and goats.
 - 1) Matthew 25:31-46
- 4. Vs 15
 - a) "he will rule them with a rod of iron"
- 5. The "rod of iron" denotes absolute sovereignty in His reign as King of kings.
 - a) Psalm 2:6-9

- b) Revelation 2:27 (Thyatira)
- 6. Vs 15
 - a) "He will tread the winepress of the fury of the rath of God the Almighty."
- 7. Vs 16
 - a) As Christ leads forth His Armies in victory, John sees a name written on His thigh, "KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS"
 - 1) Of all the kings on earth, He is KING!!
 - 2) Of all the earthly lords (those in authority) He is Lord.
- 8. Romans 14:11
- 9. Isaiah 9:6

IV. THE <u>VICTORY</u> OF CHRIST

- A. ALL VULTURES WELCOME
 - 1. Vs 17-18
 - 2. All the vultures of earth are invited to come and feast on the carcasses of those who fall before the sword of the Lord.
 - 3. There are 2 Suppers in Chapter 19
 - a) The Marriage Supper of the Lamb
 - b) and "the great supper of God"
 - 4. Vs 21

- 1. It is amazing how mankind gathers together to make a stand against God.
 - a) Notice who makes up this army.

 - a) "kings of the earth"
