INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Eternal State (Heaven) is going to be a reality for us beyond our wildest expectations.
- 2. Imagine a place where there is no more "bad news"!!
 - a) No more pain. No more weeping. No more death. No more heartache.
- 3. We will dwell with God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, forever.
 - a) This was God's intention from the beginning of creation.
- 4. One day there will be a New Heaven. A New Earth. And a New Jerusalem.

I. THE NEW HEAVEN AND EARTH

- 1. Revelation 21:1, 5
- 2. Things in the Millenium look pretty good.
 - a) Isaiah 11:6-9
 - b) Isaiah 35:1-10
- 3. There is somewhat of a mystery on what happens when God makes the New Heaven and the New Earth.
 - a) Hebrews 11:13, 16
- 4. According to 2 Peter 3:13, the main difference between this world and the next is Moral, "In which righteousness dwells."
- 5. Isaiah 65:17; 66:22
 - a) "Shall remain before me"
- 6. **QUESTION**: How is God going to bring the New Heaven and earth into existence?
 - a) 2 Peter 3:10-12
- 7. Revelation 21:1
 - a) "and I saw a new heaven and a new earth"
 - b) "for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away"
 - Does John mean that the heavens above us is destroyed?"

- 2) NO what it means is that this earth will be renovated and redeemed.
- 8. LISTEN UP: I think that this earth is our home forever!!!
 - a) The Gk. word for "passed away" does not mean extinction or annihilation.
 - 1) What it means is a change from one place to another.
 - b) When John says, "passed away" it means it passes from one condition to another.
 - 1) It means to go through a renovation.

9. 2 Peter 3:6-7

a) "stored up for fire" - is the cleansing fire, The rejuvenating fire, The purging fire

10. W.A. Criswell said this:

- a) "As for me, I like the prospect of our home being forever on this earth."
- b) "We shall break bread together in the new and happy land; we shall dine together world without end."
- c) Luke 24:36-43

II. THE NEW JERUSALEM

- 1. The longing for a city from God goes all the way back to the book of Genesis.
 - a) We learn in the book of Hebrews that Abraham, was looking forward to the city.
 - 1) Hebrews 11:10
- 2. When studying the Bible, we must use good Hermeneutics.
 - a) Hermeneutics is the science of interpretation.
 - b) A good rule of thumb is "When common sense makes plain sense, seek no other sense."

A. THE SIZE OF THE CITY OF GOD

- 1. The size of this city will accommodate all the saved since the beginning of time.
 - a) Matthew 7:13
 - b) Matthew 7:21

2. Vs 15-16

- a) "The city lies four-square"
 - 1) Four-square simply means that the city is a box whose height and length are exactly the same.

- b) "stadia" = 1380 miles
- 3. That means the area on which it sets (footprint) would comprise of 1,904,400 square miles.
- 4. **WOW!!!** But since it is a cube, we measure $W \times L \times Height = 2,628,072,000$ Cubic Miles.
- 5. The base of the city is roughly 10 times the size of France and Germany.
 - a) And 40 times the size of England.
- 6. Because the city is a cube, there will be multiple levels.
 - a) John 14:2-3

B. THE <u>DETAILS</u> OF THE CITY OF GOD

1. IT'S A HOLY CITY

- a) Our cities have sin and filth and pollution and crime and poverty and disease and anger and turmoil. THEY ARE NOT CITIES OF GOD
- b) The CITY OF GOD will have none of those things, for it will be Holy.

 1) And every resident will be Holy.

2. THE PEARLY GATES

- a) Revelation 21:21
 - 1) "and the twelve gates were twelve pearls, each of the gates made of a single pearl."
- b) Vs 10-14

3. THE FOUNDATION

- a) Vs 19-20
- b) We may not know exactly what these stones look like, but what we do know is that they will be beautiful!!
 - 1) More beautiful than anything we can imagine.
- c) The City of God will reflect the beauty of the Son of God and the infinite blessings He has provided.

4. THE STREETS OF GOLD

- a) Vs 21
 - 1) "and the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass."
- b) Somehow, this gold is so pure that light seems to go right through it like golden glass.

- c) Vs 23
 - 1) The city is illuminated solely by the Glory of God.
 - 2) Cf. Exodus 3:1-5
 - 3) 1 John 1:5

5. THE TREE OF LIFE

- a) Revelation 22:1-5
 - 1) Chrystal clear water flows from the throne of God on either side of which was the Tree of Life.
 - 2) That which was taken away in the Garden of Eden is restored.
- b) Vs 2
 - 1) Yes, we will be eating in eternity.
 - 2) Luke 24:42-43
 - 3) Matthew 26:29
 - 4) Vs 2
 - a. Fruit on the Tree of Life renews itself once a month.
