I. THERE ARE SIX THINGS THAT WON'T BE IN HEAVEN

A. FIRST - THERE WILL BE NO SANCTUARIES IN HEAVEN

- 1. Revelation 21:3, 22
- 2. There will be no temple, or physical tabernacle.
- 3. Very Important: But God does not dwell in buildings in this age!!
 - a) In the Old Testament God met His people in the Holy of Holies.
 - b) But today He dwells in His people, in the person of the Holy Spirit.

B. SECOND - THERE WILL BE NO <u>LIGHT</u> <u>HOLDERS</u> IN HEAVEN

- 1. Revelation 21:23
- 2.1 John 1:5
- 3. Genesis 1:3, 14-19
- 4. There will be no need for the Sun and moon.
- 5. "for the glory of God gives it light, and it's lamp is the Lamb."
- 6. Daniel 12:3

C. THIRDLY - THERE WILL BE NO SICKNESS IN HEAVEN

- 1. No longer will there be need for a church prayer chain.
- 2. Revelation 21:4
- 3. But think of it!!!
 - a) NO MORE SICKNESS!!!

D. FOURTHLY - THERE WILL BE NO HEARTACHE IN HEAVEN

- 1. Vs 4
 - a) "He will wipe away every tear from their eyes"
- 2. Cf. Revelation 7:17

- a) John saw the Lamb wiping away tears from the saints who had been martyred.
- 3. Now in Revelation 21:4, chronologically this comes after
 - a) The Judgment Seat of Christ
 - b) And The Great White Throne Judgment

4. I Corinthians 3:10-15

- a) The Judgment Seat of Christ will be a great day for some, but a sad day for others.
- b) 2 Corinthians 5:10
- 5. To disregard Christ's words, and live selfishly is to build foolishly using worthless materials.
- 6. Believers are not judged as to Salvation @ the Judgment Seat of Christ but as to their faithfulness to Christ.
 - a) The response of the believer who has done little for Christ will be heartbreaking!!!

7. Matthew 26:75

- a) Peter wept bitterly over his failure to be loyal to Jesus.
- 8. Think about all the wasted opportunities, broken promises, words spoken in anger, and sins not repented of!!
- 9. Revelation 20:11-15
- 10. I think some of us will cry so hard because of failed opportunities, that God will literally have to wipe our tears away.
 - a) And there will be no tears in the Eternal State.

E. FIFTHLY - THERE WILL BE NO SEPARATION IN HEAVEN

- 1. We will never again be separated from those we love.
- 2. John was writing from the isle of Patmos, having been sent there to die by the Roman Emperor Domitian to die of exposure and starvation.

F. SIXTHLY - THERE WILL BE NO SIN IN HEAVEN

1. Revelation 21:8: 27

2. Revelation 22:15

3. Revelation 22:3

- a) Cf. Genesis 3:17-19
 - 1) When Adam sinned all of creation fell under the curse.
- b) But because Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, He now sets us free from the ability to sin.
- 4. There will be no "bad news" in Heaven.

II. THREE THINGS THAT WE WILL BE IN HEAVEN

A. WE WILL WORSHIP

- 1. Revelation 22:3
 - a) Revelation contains 14 Songs.
- 2. Seems clear that singing and Worship was is and will be, a priority in Heaven.
- 3. Worship is a priority!! John 4:23

B. WE WILL BE SERVING

- 1. Revelation 22:3
 - a) The context for serving God and the Lamb, is the THRONE.
 - b) All who have been used of God here on earth are referred to as servants.

(Revelation (1:1; 7:3; 10:7; 11:18 etc.)

- 2. What exactly will we be doing to serve God in Heaven?
 - a) ANSWER: I believe we will do exactly what our hearts desire.
 - b) We will do what we thought we were made to do.

C. WE WILL FELLOWSHIP

- 1. Heaven is going to be the greatest experience of fellowship you and I have ever had.
- 2. There will be millions and millions of believers.
