GROWING IN GRACE

"The Obstacle of Spiritual Growth" 2 Peter 3:18

INTRODUCTION

- 1. GRACE @ work:
 - a) It is by Grace we are SAVED.
 - b) It is the same Grace that releases Holy Spirit power so that He can LIVE through us.
 - c) AND it is the goal of this Spiritual Growth to produce HOLINESS in the believers life.
- 2.1 Peter 1:14-16
- 3. That means living in conformity with the Person of Christ and the Truth of Scripture.
- 4. Jesus referred to this flow of God's Grace and Power when He stood up in Jerusalem one day @ The feast of Tabernacles and said:
 - a) John 7:37-39
- 5. **Vs 38**
 - a) "Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."
- 6. Vs 39
 - a) This promise is to EVERYONE who believes in HIM.
- 7. **HOWEVER** There is an obstacle of Hindrance to this flow of GRACE that will hinder Spiritual Growth.
 - a) What is that Hindrance? SIN
- 8. WE HAVE THREE FORMIDABLE FOES WAGING WAR AGAINST US.
 - a) FIRST The World (an Evil System)
 - 1) 1 John 5:19
 - b) **SECOND** The Flesh (our old **Desires**)
 - 1) Romans 7:14-15
 - c) THIRD The Devil (an Evil Person)
 - 1) Revelation 12:9
- 9. BUT HERE'S THE GOOD NEWS!!!
 - a) We are not alone, because Jesus has OVERCOME the WORLD.
 - 1) John 16:33
 - 2) 1 John 4:4
 - b) Jesus has OVERCOME the FLESH (Evil Desires)

- 1) Romans 7:25
- c) Jesus has OVERCOME the devil and stripped him of his power (an Evil person)
 - 1) Hebrews 2:14

I. SIN SEPARATES US FROM GOD

A. A LOSS OF FELLOWSHIP

- 1. Romans 5:1
- 2. The loss of Fellowship is the issue for Christians.
 - a) Why because our relationship with God was eternally settled @ Salvation.
 - b) Romans 5:19
- 3. Justification in the New Testament is a legal term that means to be declared righteous.
- 4. When we come to Christ for the forgiveness of sin, God places our sin on Christs account, AND credits Christ's righteousness to our account.
 - a) This allows God to render a legal decision, declaring us **RIGHTEOUS** because we are in Christ.
 - b) 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - 1) This is the WONDROUS EXCHANGE
 - 2) This is the EXCHANGE of our SIN for Christs Righteousness by which we are made FIT to ENTER HEAVEN.
- 5. If you have never put your faith and trust in Christ for Salvation, <u>you have</u> <u>already been declared guilty in the courtroom of God</u>.

B. FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD MUST BE NURTURED

- 1.1 John 3:9
- 2. This has to do with sin that contaminates the life of a believer.
- 3. QUESTION: How many of us here today struggle with sin?
- 4. Listen Up: The day is coming when Jesus will deliver us not only from sin's power, but from it's very PRESENCE.
- 5. UNTIL THEN we must deal with it!!!
 - a) However, we have a POWERFUL ALLY God's GRACE!!!

- 6. Simple definition of Grace: Is God's inexhaustible supply of goodness whereby He does for you what you could never do for yourself.
- 7. VERY, VERY IMPORTANT: As GRACE flows to us and THROUGH us, it stimulates the GROWTH of our NEW NATURE.
- 8.1 John 3:9
 - a) "for God's seed abides in him"
- 9. THAT SEED CANNOT SIN!!!
 - a) It is impossible for anything that comes from God to be contaminated by sin in any way!!
 - 1) Our **NEW NATURE** is without flaw and cannot sin.
 - b) **BUT WE STILL STRUGGLE** with sin because our **NEW NATURE** is living in the **OLD HOUSE** of our sin contaminated flesh.
- 10. Roman's 6:6
- 11. Our New Nature exists in the OLD FLESH, and they are DIAMETRICALLY opposed to each other.
 - a) Galatians 5:17

II. WE MUST <u>ACKNOWLEGE</u> OUR SIN TO GOD

1. QUESTION: Do you feel like sin might have the upper hand in your BATTLE?

A. GOD HATES SIN

- 1. 1 John 1:5
 - a) "God is light"
 - 1) Light stands for absolute Holiness and Purity.
- 2. ALWAYS REMEMBER Darkness and Evil cannot exist in perfect light.
- 3. FACT SIN REPULSES GOD
 - a) Exodus 19:21-24
 - 1) God has place "NO TRESPASSING" signs around His Holiness.
- 4. KNOW THIS: NO SIN can exist in God's light (presence).
 - a) We have to realize that our sin; even as believers; creates a barrier between us and a HOLY GOD.
- 5.1 John 1:5

a) "In Him is no darkness @ all."

B. WE ADJUST TO DARKNESS

- 1. Stepping from light into a darkness.
 - a) Your eyes need some time to adjust.
 - b) AND before you know it, you can function and get around.
- 2. Here's the big problem we adjust to sin, GOD DOES NOT.
- 3. God and sin are not compatible.
 - a) AND sin cuts off fellowship with God.
 - b) When fellowship is cut off, there is no growth.

4. SPIRITUAL GROWTH MUST HAVE LIGHT

a) God's Grace is experienced in the light.

C. SIN IS A CONTRADICTION TO THE CHRISTIAN LIFE

- 1. 1 John 1:6
 - a) "If we say that we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness"
 - b) "we lie and do not the truth"
- 2. **PLEASE LISTEN UP:** "If you Practice sin and fail to deal with it God will not show up in your life.
- 3. **VS** 7
 - a) Now we are talking about "fellowship with one another"

D. WE MUST WALK IN THE LIGHT

- 1. Vs 7c
- 2. Vs 8
- 3. The darkness in us is most fully exposed when we come into the PURE LIGHT OF GOD'S HOLY PRESENCE.

III. THE NEED FOR CONFESSION

- 1. WE HAVE 2 CHOICES:
 - a) Cover Up

- b) Clean Up
- 2. 1 John 1:9
- 3. Cf. Vs 7
 - a) "cleanses us from all sin"
 - 1) "cleanses us" means "and keeps on cleaning"

A. CONFESSION IS AGREEING WITH GOD

- 1. 1 John 1:9
 - a) "confess" means to agree or say the same thing!!!
- 2. 1 John 1:9
 - a) "sins" plural
- 3. 1 John 1:9
 - a) "faithful" means it's a guarantee

B. KEEP CONFESSIONS UP TO DATE

- 1. 1 John 1:9
 - a) "and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness"
