# "Why We Must Grow Spiritually" 2 Peter 3:18

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. One of the greatest tragedies of the 20th century was the sinking of the Titanic.
- 2. 2 Peter 3:18
  - a) "But grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ"

    1) That is a command!!
- 3. This new series is about Spiritual Growth, and God expects us to grow.
  - a) If you are truly a Born-Again Christian, you have life abiding in you.
- 4. **THIS IS BIG**: The Grace that saved you, is the Grace that will transform you as you grow.
  - a) Spiritual Growth is guaranteed.
- 5. Galatians 4:18-19

## I. THE NECESSITY OF SPIRITUAL GROWTH

- 1. Getting a handle on Spiritual Growth is crucial for @ least 2 reasons.
  - a) First It is God's command that we Grow.
    - 1) And that means it is God's will.
  - b) **Second** The opposite of Growth is stagnation and stunted growth.
- 2. A good definition of Spiritual Growth:
  - a) "It is the transformation process by which we allow the indwelling Christ to increasingly express Himself in and through us, bringing God greater glory and experience His greater good for ourselves."
- 3. Spiritual Growth is more of Christ being expressed in my life through less of me.
  - a) John 3:30

# A. GROWTH DEMANDS NOURISHMENT

- 1.1 Peter 2:2
- 2. The issue of a newborn baby is growth.

- 3. Spiritual Growth is not a program or curriculum, but the nourishment and development of a life.
- 4. The goal of Spiritual Growth is to feed the life you were given by the Holy Spirit @ the moment of your conversion.
  - a) 1 Peter 2:1-2
  - b) **Ephesians 4:15**
- 5. **Very Important**: Your Spiritual DNA is complete because you got the Life of Christ @ your conversion, and nothing can be added to Christ!!
  - a) When you got saved you got all of Jesus you will ever have!!
- 6. **NOW WATCH THIS**: Our challenge as Christians is to **maximize** what we **already have**.

## B. GROWTH IS DEPENDANT ON A RELATIONSHIP

- 1. A baby depends on his/her mother for the nourishment needed to grow.
- 2. Before birth the baby draws nourishment from the mother through the umbilical cord.
  - a) The mother's life supplying life to the baby.
  - b) If that relationship is disrupted, the baby is in serious trouble.
- 3. John 10:10
- 4.1 Corinthians 2:9
- 5. So, if we are not experiencing the abundant life, then maybe it's because we messed up our relationship with Him or traded it for something less.
- 6. Spiritual growth is progressively learning to let Christ live His life through us, and that only happens through relationship.

## II. WHAT IT TAKES TO GROW SPIRITUALLY

- 1. 2 Peter 3:18
  - a) "But grow in Grace and Knowledge"
- 2. Grace and Knowledge work together to enhance our growth.
- 3. Our growth is connected to the person of Jesus Christ.
  - a) The One whose life flows through our spiritual veins.

## A. THE SUBSTANCE OF GRACE

- 1. Simple definition of Grace: Is God's inexhaustible supply of goodness whereby He does for you what you could never do for yourself.
- 2. It is a gift that can only be received and enjoyed, not earned.
- 3. Colossians 2:6
- 4. Grace is all that God is FREE to do for you based on the work of Jesus Christ on your behalf.
- 5. NOW LISTEN UP: When we think of growth, it suggests effort on our part, while grace is a gift that can only be received and enjoyed, not earned.
- 6. Colossians 2:6

## B. PUT KNOWLEDGE TO WORK

- 1. 2 Peter 3:18
  - a) "But grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ"
- 2. Peter tells us as believers to grow in the knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- 3. **VERY IMPORTANT**: We have everything we need to put the ingredients of knowledge to work in our lives.
- 4. Information about the Christian faith is crucial!!!

#### III. WHAT SPIRITUAL GROWTH PRODUCES

- 1. 2 Peter 3:18
  - a) "To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity."
- 2. VERY IMPORTANT: Please write this down!!!!
  - a) "God is passionate about His GLORY"!!!
- 3. Because God is passionate about His GLORY, He wants us to KNOW Him, and SEEK Him, and GROW in Him.
  - a) WHY? Because we are to be people through which He can express Himself and DISPLAY His Magnificent Glory.

## A. THE REASON WE WERE CREATED

1. The goal of Spiritual Growth is to expand and increase our capacity to bring God Glory.

#### 2. GOD EXISTS FOR HIS GLORY!!!

- a) The definition of Glory: means to be heavy or weighty...wow.
- b) It is to manifest His PERFECT character, especially His righteousness.

#### 3. Romans 3:23

- a) God defines sin as a failure to bring Glory to God.
- 4. LISTEN UP: We are not sinners because we do bad things, but because in our sin we fail to live up to the purpose for which God created us...which is to Glorify Him.

#### 5. Romans 1:18ff

- 6. Glory also has to do with the way that something attracts attention to Him and to promote Him as worthy of all praise and adoration.
- 7. God wants to go public, and our FULL-TIME job is to make Him visible to the world, so that they might come to Him.

## B. IT MUST BECOME YOUR PASSION

- 1. Is it your passion to live for GOD'S GLORY?
- 2. Once you make God's Glory your passion your whole life will be consumed with God's Glory.

#### 3.1 Corinthians 10:31

4. WHEN YOU ARE PASSIONATE ABOUT YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST and committed to bringing Him GLORY, your Spiritual life will grow at a speed you never imagined possible.
